No 4: RAEME TIES

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RAEME Corps Tie

1. The RAEME Corps Tie may be worn with civilian attire by:
 - a. serving officers and other ranks of RAEME,
 - b. ex-members of the Corps, and
 - c. other persons authorised by the SO2 Corps.
2. The description of the RAEME Corps Tie is as shown in Annex A, colours are as follows:
 - a. Widely spaced pairs of parallel stripes on a dark blue (BCC 219 – Purple Navy) background running diagonally downwards from the left shoulder of the wearer at an angle of forty five degrees.
 - b. The stripes are:
 - (1) Gold (BCC No 14) approximately 1.5mm wide
 - (2) Scarlet (BCC No 210 - Union Jack Red) approximately 1.5mm wide
 - (3) Pairs of stripes are 110 mm apart and centrally located on the tie face between each pair of stripes is a RAEME crest 22mm high.
 - c. On the broad end of the tie, the gold stripe is above the scarlet stripe .
 - d. The ties may be purchased from the Bandiana Military Museum.
