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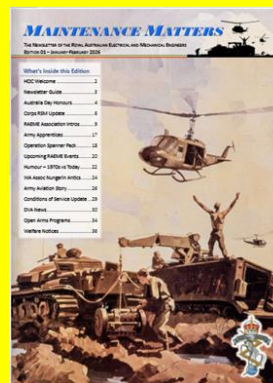

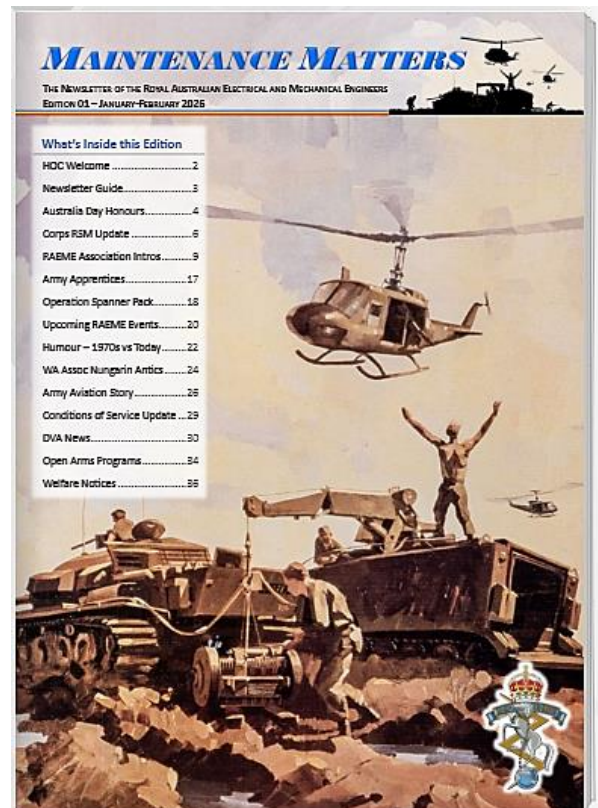

The President, Secretary and Treasurer all presented reports.

Finance

An audited statement was provided.

The financial position remains very strong for the Association with net position \$16,390 including a new Term Deposit of \$5,000 and merchandise on hand of \$2,850.

Major items covered include:

- Greg Rosser advised that the RAEME Nation Network will be introducing a new national monthly(?) Newsletter which is yet to be named. It will be on-line for easy review and promises to change the way RAEME information is distributed in the future. The ACT Association will expand their Current RAEME in ACTION newsletter to cover the new format but will require help from all the other regional Associations.

 - Brian Holmes (Currently in hospital (hospice) and not expected to last the year)
 - John Howard – for his ongoing support as Historian
 - Bob Matthew - for his ongoing support as Membership Officer, Treasurer and Merchandising Member
- It was agreed that we would wait for a request from the OC 43 Army Cadet Unit regarding continued financial support for 43 Army Cadet Unit (usually for the sum of \$200).
